Terms and Conditions

1. Eligibility Requirements

To participate in the Hanyang Model United Nations, participants must meet the following criteria:

- Participants must be between 13 and 20 years of age (Korean age) or currently enrolled as university students (no age limit).
- Exceptions may be made for those attending middle or high school beyond the age range, at the discretion of the Secretariat.

Failure to meet these eligibility requirements may result in disqualification from the conference and restrictions on future participation.

2. Committee and Delegation Assignment

- Each participant will be assigned a country to represent during the conference.
- Participants must provide their preferred country delegation and committee when submitting their application. While preferences will be considered, assignments may vary based on application order, availability, and relevant experience.

It is the participant's responsibility to accurately complete the application, including personal information, preferred delegation, and committee.

3. Pledge of Participation

All participants are required to read and sign the Pledge of Participation, which outlines the terms and expectations for participation before and during the conference. The signed pledge must be submitted at registration on the first day of the conference.

The Pledge of Participation will only be considered valid if:

- The document is properly submitted.
- The document is printed in its entirety.
- The document is signed by the participant.

4. Refund Policies

Participants who wish to withdraw from the conference and request a refund must submit the

Official Refund Form to hanyangmodelun@gmail.com. The following conditions apply:

- Refund requests must be received by the deadline. Forms submitted after this deadline will not be accepted.

5. Attitude and Demeanor

Discriminatory actions or statements based on race, gender, sexual orientation, nationality, religion, age, disability, or appearance are strictly prohibited. Participants engaging in such behavior will face the following consequences, as determined by the Secretariat:

- Verbal caution.
- Disqualification from the conference without refund.
- Ineligibility for future HMUN conferences and related events.
- Potential legal actions and contact with relevant authorities.

Participants must adhere to the following dress code:

- Formal attire is required.
- School uniforms are permitted but not recommended.
- School uniforms with visible school logos are prohibited.

Failure to comply with the dress code may result in:

- Removal from award considerations.
- Disqualification from receiving a certificate of participation.

6. Exceptions and Violations

The office of Hanyang University's School of International Studies and the Secretary General of HMUN reserve the right to make exceptions to these terms and conditions on a case-by-case basis. Violations of the terms and conditions, the Code of Conduct, or the Rules of Procedure may result in:

- Disqualification from the conference without refund.
- Prohibition from participating in future HMUN conferences and related events.

Participants should be aware that serious violations may lead to permanent exclusion from future HMUN events.
